DISCUSSION ON PAVILION

Commissioner O'Malley opened the inaugural meeting by stating that the committee was formed to increase communication between staff, Commissioners and the public with regards to the Pavilion. Commissioner Cooke added that this committee will provide the basis for discussions regarding numerous items ranging from building maintenance to suggestions for improving visitors' experiences. Various staff members will be invited to attend each meeting.

Superintendent Collier listed the job responsibilities for the Recreation Facility Supervisor recently hired for the Pavilion. Duties include taking over Open Gym and Security as well as the inspection of safety equipment. The Manager and Assistant Manager of the Pavilion Fitness Center will be taking on additional responsibilities in their roles as the Center's needs are reorganized.

Director Greene and Superintendent Collier provided an update on the future renovation of Jumps and Jiggles. They are working on their vision. This will include input from a QR Code directed survey that will be made available to users of the facility. While no timeline is currently set, they are anticipating the renovation being on the 2025 Capitals list.

Maintenance, access and coverage of the camera system was discussed. Access to footage is limited for security reasons and maintenance should be handled through the proper channels. Director Curcio stated that the Park District can expand camera coverage.

Commissioner O'Malley wants to ensure that the Marketing Department is utilizing every avenue available to reach residents with regards to programs and events. He would like staff from Marketing to attend a future meeting to discuss.

Director Greene and Superintendent Collier discussed with the Commissioners how to attract different demographics to the Pavilion Fitness Center. Superintendent Collier stated that the Center wanted to be up-to-date on the current trends in the world of fitness and how that specifically relates to the 20 to 40 year old demographic.

The Commissioners expressed that they wanted to look at the pricing structure, return on investment, duplicity of equipment, towel service, hours of operation and how to benefit the most people when monies are spent.

Director Greene gave a target date of mid-July for completion of the Rejuvenation area. However, the door for the area will not be installed until mid-August. In the meantime, the Rejuvenation area will be available, upon its completion, for patrons to explore and experience. A system for determining time slots for using the area is still being worked out.

Director Greene and Superintendent Collier reiterated that no equipment is being eliminated due to the functional training renovations. Furthermore, the wall will be coming down in late summer or early fall. Locker room sprayers and general maintenance of the bathrooms by custodial staff was also discussed.

The Commissioners and Director Curcio discussed the lack of a bathroom by the lap pool/outdoor pool and the possibility of putting that addition on a futures Capitals list.
