- The anticipated start date for the Hattendorf OSLAD grant project is some time in the fall, and should be completed by December.
- > We are still waiting to hear if we received the grant for the golf course project, however; the project is still moving forward.
- ➤ The Lagoon Pool Water Replacement project will start August 13 with a completion date of August 28.
- ➤ A Capitals Meeting is scheduled for August 13 to review the Big 10 list.

FINANCE COMMITTEE

Commissioner Souder gave the following update:

Corporate Fund -

- ➤ Net year to date of \$1,593,000 compared to a budget of \$935,000.
- ➤ The 2020 Net year to date of \$1,593,000 compared to a 2019 Net year to date of \$1,173,000.
- ➤ All expense categories are under budget except for insurance due to unemployment claims.

Recreation Fund

➤ Net revenue of (\$54,000) compared to a budgeted amount of \$102,000.

Golf Fund

- ➤ Golf Fund Net loss of \$17,000 compared to a budgeted loss of \$57,000.
- \rightarrow The 2020 Net year to date of (\$17,000) compared to a 2019 Net year to date of (\$60,000).
- ➤ All expense categories are at or under budget.
- > Driving Range Revenue in June was \$46,920 versus a budget of \$32,650
- ➤ In June, rounds were down but fees were up \$9,000.

COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE

President O'Malley stated the majority of the discussion at the July 9 meeting was in regards to the financing for the Golf Course project. The consensus of the Board was to go with a 6 year repayment plan that was heavy upfront to offer financial flexibility for the future. There was also a discussion about Pirates Cove and whether or not to have staff pursue opening this summer. At tonight's meeting, there was a Pirates Cove update and discussion on Athletic programs moving forward.

ATHLETIC COMMITTEE

Commissioner Biedke gave the following update:

- ➤ A President's Meeting will be scheduled to take place at Garden Terrace. More information on that to come.
- > Travel Baseball will be hosting tryouts for next season on August 23 at Lions.

- ➤ Football registration has been extended through July 28. The season is dependent on Covid.
- > IHSA is meeting tomorrow. They will then come out with recommendations that staff will use.
- ➤ The Bill George Youth Football League (BGYFL) has come out with a tentative schedule. The first week of practice will be August 17-21. The first games will take place on September 12 and 13. They will follow IHSA guidelines.

GOLF COURSE COMMITTEE

Commissioner Walz said he and Commissioner Souder are the new committee members. They met and are trying to prepare how to explain the financing for the new clubhouse and maintenance facility. Commissioner Walz added that people at the golf course are extremely excited about this project. Commissioner Souder shared that this project has been in discussion for a number of years as the maintenance facility needed to be renovated.

President O'Malley stated that the Driving Range is a great contributor to the success of the golf course and would like to see some improvements done there. Commissioner Walz responded that his impression is that we lease that property and can only do so much there.

YOUTH COMMITTEE

Commissioner Biedke announced the annual Teen Bonfire has been cancelled due to Covid19.

ADULT CENTER COMMITTEE

Commissioner Cooke said that hopefully the Adult Center will open September 8.

FOUNDATION UPDATE

Commissioner Cooke stated the Foundation Committee met on July 21. They discussed the administration fee to handle funds coming in through sports fundraising. They also discussed whether the dance and travel programs should be eligible for scholarships. They agreed at this point that the money can be used towards whatever program they choose. The cost to purchase a leaf for the Giving Tree at the Pavilion will go down to \$200. It initially cost \$1,000 but was decreased to \$500 last year.

Commissioner Biedke announced two new members of the Foundation are Scott Saxe and Don Elder saying they are a great addition to the Foundation. Commissioner Biedke added that anyone that would like to make a donation to the Foundation can reach out to the Park District.

PAYMENT OF BILLS

Commissioner Souder moved to authorize Director Curcio to make payment of the bills in the amount of \$64,202.12 P-cards for July 9, 2020, \$143,676.31 for July 9, 2020 and \$58.560.21 for July 16, 2020.
